## Annex No. 2 of General rules for ARC Endurance

## Conditions for participation of a driver aged 16 – 18

- 1. A driver can start in any division. The legal representative is responsible for the driver's training, confirms that the driver has perfect control of the vehicle entrusted to him and the rules of racing on a closed circuit, both solo and in a group.
- 2. The minimum age of a driver on race day is 16 years and one day. This fact is evidenced by the legal representative with an official document (ID card, passport, birth certificate).
- 3. The reversal to the race shall be signed by at least one legal representative upon presentation of a document proving his/her status. This legal representative must be present in the driver's pits at all times.
- 4. During the first participation of a driver in the ARC Endurance series, the driver is obliged to prove to the technical marshals in the presence of a legal representative that he is able to safely and unaided leave the vehicle with which he will participate in the race within the specified time. When changing vehicles, he demonstrates this skill repeatedly.
- 5. During the administrative check for the race, the driver shall present a medical certificate on the form (Annex No. 7) issued by ARC Endurance stating that he or she is medically fit to participate in the race, or with what limitations (dioptric glasses, etc.).
- 6. Even if the above conditions are met, there is no legal entitlement for a minor to participate in the race. The final approval is given by the race director, taking into account external circumstances.
